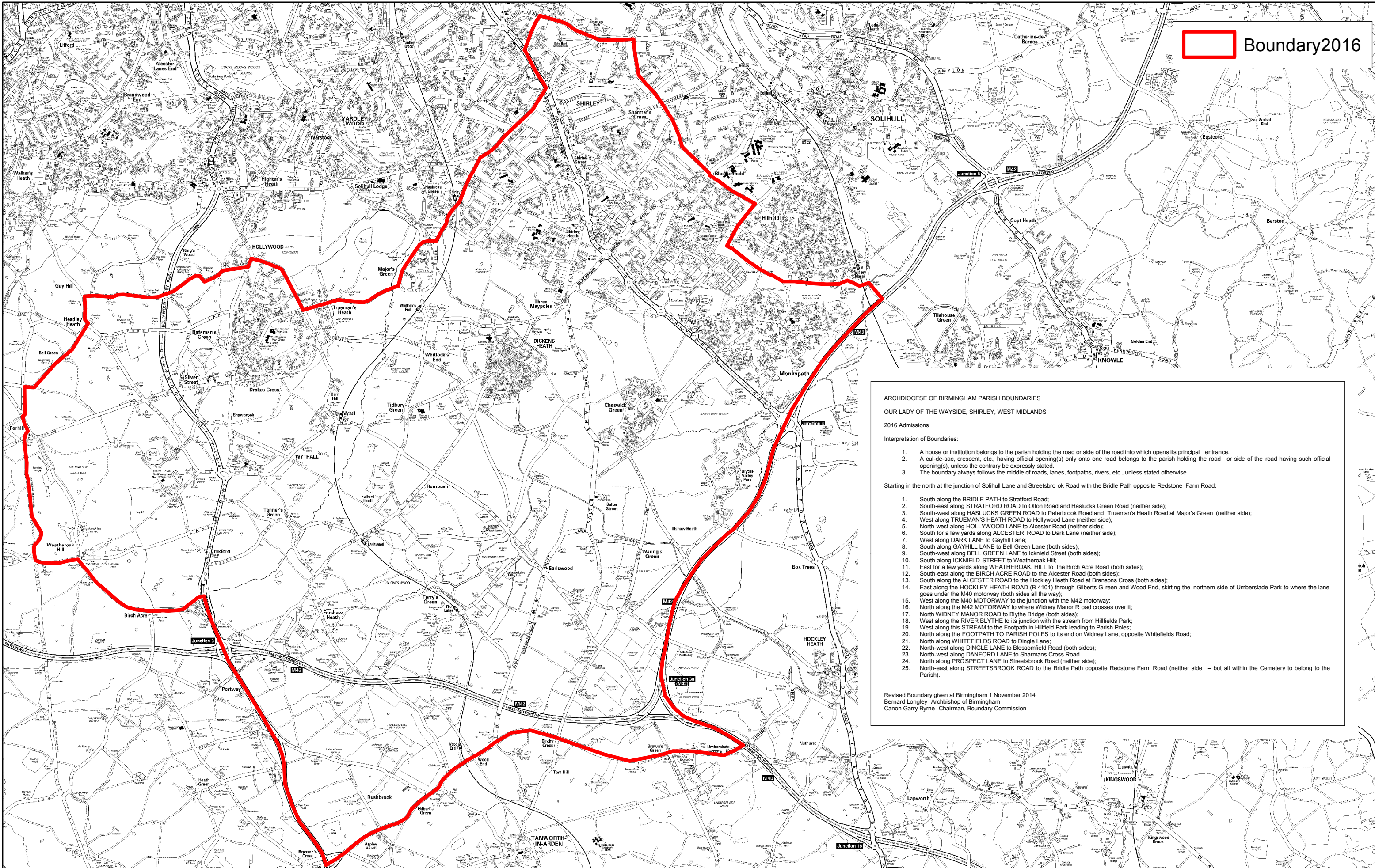

OUR LADY OF THE WAYSIDE, SHIRLEY, WEST MIDLANDS  
2016 Admissions  
Interpretation of Boundaries:

1. A house or institution belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road into which opens its principal entrance.
2. A cul-de-sac, crescent, etc., having official opening(s) only onto one road belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road having such official opening(s), unless the contrary be expressly stated.
3. The boundary always follows the middle of roads, lanes, footpaths, rivers, etc., unless stated otherwise.

Starting in the north at the junction of Solihull Lane and Streetsbrook Road with the Bridle Path opposite Redstone Farm Road:

1. South along the BRIDLE PATH to Stratford Road;
2. South-east along STRATFORD ROAD to Olton Road and Haslucks Green Road (neither side);
3. South-west along HASLUCKS GREEN ROAD to Peterbrook Road and Trueman's Heath Road at Major's Green (neither side);
4. West along TRUEMAN'S HEATH ROAD to Hollywood Lane (neither side);
5. North-west along HOLLYWOOD LANE to Alcester Road (neither side);
6. South for a few yards along ALCESTER ROAD to Dark Lane (neither side);
7. West along DARK LANE to Gayhill Lane;
8. South along GAYHILL LANE to Bell Green Lane (both sides);
9. South-west along BELL GREEN LANE to Icknield Street (both sides);
10. South along ICKNIELD STREET to Weatheroak Hill;
11. East for a few yards along WEATHEROAK HILL to the Birch Acre Road (both sides);
12. South-east along the BIRCH ACRE ROAD to the Alcester Road (both sides);
13. South along the ALCESTER ROAD to the Hockley Heath Road at Bransons Cross (both sides);
14. East along the HOCKLEY HEATH ROAD (B 4101) through Gilberts Green and Wood End, skirting the northern side of Umberlade Park to where the lane goes under the M40 motorway (both sides all the way);
15. West along the M40 MOTORWAY to the junction with the M42 motorway;
16. North along the M42 MOTORWAY to where Widney Manor Road crosses over it;
17. North WIDNEY MANOR ROAD to Blythe Bridge (both sides);
18. West along the RIVER BLYTHE to its junction with the stream from Hillfields Park;
19. West along this STREAM to the Footpath in Hillfield Park leading to Parish Poles;
20. North along the FOOTPATH TO PARISH POLES to its end on Widney Lane, opposite Whitefields Road;
21. North along WHITEFIELDS ROAD to Dingle Lane;
22. North-west along DINGLE LANE to Blossomfield Road (both sides);
23. North-west along DANFORD LANE to Sharmans Cross Road;
24. North along PROSPECT LANE to Streetsbrook Road (neither side);
25. North-east along STREETSBOOK ROAD to the Bridle Path opposite Redstone Farm Road (neither side - but all within the Cemetery to belong to the Parish).
